



**SECTION 7 – HEALTH HAZARDS AND FIRST AID****EFFECTS OF OVER-EXPOSURE:**

**SKIN:** Prolonged exposure to skin may result in the absorption of harmful amounts of methanol. Repeated contact may cause irritation, defatting or drying.

**EYES:** Eye irritant. May cause irritation, redness or tearing.

**INHALATION:** Vapors may cause dizziness or drowsiness.

**INGESTION:** May cause abdominal pain, vomiting, headache, shortness of breath, weakness, fatigue, light-headedness, drunkenness or blurred vision.

**FIRST-AID PROCEDURES:**

**SKIN:** Flush exposed area with plenty of water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Remove contaminated clothing and launder before reuse.

**EYES:** Immediately flush with large quantities of water for at least 15 minutes, lifting upper and lower eyelids occasionally. Seek medical attention.

**INHALATION:** Remove person to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. If irritation persists get medical attention.

**INGESTION:** Dilute by giving water or milk and then induce vomiting.

**NOTE:** Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing victim. Keep person warm and quiet. Get medical attention immediately.

**SECTION 8 – SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION**

**RESPIRATORY PROTECTION:** Self-contained breathing apparatus if above TLV limit.

**VENTILATION:** Provide local exhaust to keep TLV of Section 2 ingredients below acceptable limit.

**PROTECTIVE GLOVES:** None required if spraying.

**EYE PROTECTION:** As with all cleaners, safety glasses or chemical splash goggles are recommended.

**OTHER PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:** Long sleeves and long pants.

**WORK/HYGIENIC PRACTICES:** *DO NOT SMOKE WHILE USING.* Wash hands after using.

**SECTION 9 – SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURE**

**STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:** Use absorbent sweeping compound to soak up material. Put into container. Dispose as hazardous waste.

**WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD:** Dispose as hazardous waste in accordance with EPA RCRA.
